Thanks for downloading Desktop Buddy: Decker V1.0.

Unzip the “DesktopBuddy-Decker-V0.1” folder to your PC, and open the “DesktopBuddy-Decker.exe” file to get started.

----- **IMPORTANT NOTICE TLDR;** -----

If the buttons are visible, but not clicking, click on the Desktop Buddy item in your task bar to activate the game window and then try clicking the buttons again.

Hover your mouse over the bottom right of your active monitor(when the Desktop Buddy application is running) to bring up the Quick Menu. The ‘Menu’ button, toggles the Main Menu, The ‘X’ button in the Quick Menu will close the Desktop Buddy application.

If running windows 8, you may need to turn off Windows Smart Screen for the application to work.

-- THIS IS A WINDOWS ONLY BUILD --

This application is still an early build and has only been through basic testing on my two home PC's running Windows 8.1 and Windows 10. So while the application itself if very basic in nature, I cannot guarantee that it will run on all PC's and operating system environments. Worst case scenario, the app will just crash. Let me know if this happens.

-- TRANSPARENT GAME WINDOW --

This application uses a transparent game window to allow you to leave the application running in the back ground, while you work on other tasks. The Decker Avatar himself can be “clicked-through”, allowing you to access windows/items behind him.

Unlike regular Windows applications, Desktop Buddy will remain visible and cannot be minimised when you click onto other Windows/your desktop. When you do this, the Desktop Buddy application will be passively running, so the animations will still play, but you won't be able to click on any of the buttons/features until Desktop Buddy is the active Window again.

Clicking on the Desktop Buddy in the task bar, or Alt+Tabing to select it as the active window will make it all work again. I'm still working on better methods to handle this “issue”.

-- QUICK MENU --

Hover your mouse over the bottom right of your active monitor(when the Desktop Buddy application is running) to bring up the Quick Menu. The ‘Menu’ button, toggles the Main Menu, The ‘X’ button in the Quick Menu will close the Desktop Buddy application. This of course only works when the Desktop Buddy application is the active window.
